The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the A55 Trunk Road (Chester–Bangor) (hereinafter referred to as “the trunk road”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1), 14(4), 14(7) and 124 of, and para 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 9 April 2013. Its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Pen-y-clip Tunnel, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions & Restrictions) Order 2013 (Variation) Order 2013.

Variation

2. The A55 Trunk Road (Pen-y-Clip Tunnel, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions & Restrictions) Order 2013 (“the Order”)(3) is varied by substituting for the words (“Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Prohibitions”) in article 1 of the English language version of the Order the words (“Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restrictions”).
