ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The M4 Motorway (Junction 32, Coryton) and the A470 Trunk Road (Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restriction) Order 2014

Made 16 September 2014

Coming into force 22 September 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London to South Wales Motorway (M4) ("the motorway") and the Cardiff to Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) ("the trunk road") are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the motorway and trunk road should be prohibited and restricted because of works proposed on or near the motorway and trunk road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 22 September 2014. Its title is the M4 Motorway (Junction 32, Coryton) and the A470 Trunk Road (Coryton Interchange, Cardiff) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions and Restriction) Order 2014.

2. (1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used for or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order or for the emergency services;

"the lengths of the motorway" ("y darnau o'r draffordd") means the lengths of the motorway specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the trunk road specified in Schedules 2 and 3 to this Order;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 22 September 2014 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed;

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions and Restriction

- **3**. Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed along the lengths of the motorway and trunk road specified in Schedules 1 and 2.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.
- **6.** Subject to the provisions of article 7, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3 during such times as the restriction referred to in article 5 is in operation.

Application

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such an extent as traffic signs indicate the application of the prohibitions and restriction referred to therein.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULE 1

Extent of prohibition of all vehicles

The M4 Motorway, Junction 32, Coryton, Cardiff

- i) The entire lengths of the westbound on and off slip roads.
- ii) The entire length of the eastbound on slip road.
- iii) That length of the eastbound off slip road that extends from a point 315 metres west of its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Coryton Roundabout to the said junction with the circulatory carriageway of Coryton Roundabout.

SCHEDULE 2

Extent of prohibition of all vehicles

The A470 Trunk Road, Coryton Interchange, Cardiff

- i) The entire length of the northbound on slip road.
- ii) The entire length of the southbound off slip road.
- iii) That length of the north-western section of the gyratory carriageway of Coryton Roundabout that extends from its junction with the A470 northbound on slip road to its junction with the A470 southbound off slip road.
- iv) That length of the eastern section of the gyratory carriageway of Coryton Roundabout that extends from its junction with the A470 southbound on slip road to its junction with the A470 northbound off slip road.

SCHEDULE 3

Extent of 10 mph Speed Limit, Prohibition of Overtaking and Prohibition of Cyclists

The A470 Trunk Road, Coryton, Cardiff

The entire length of the gyratory carriageway of Coryton Interchange Roundabout.
