The A40 Trunk Road (Raglan Interchange, Monmouthshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Right and Left Hand Turns)
Order 2014

Made 21 October 2014

Coming into force 27 October 2014

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Raglan - Llandovery Trunk Road (A40) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 27 October 2014. Its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Raglan Interchange, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Right and Left Hand Turns) Order 2014.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means those lengths of the A40 trunk road at Raglan Interchange and Raglan Bypass in the County of Monmouthshire specified in the Schedules to this Order.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

- **3.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1.
- **4.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall use or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to make a right hand turn in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2.
- **5.** Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall use or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to make a left hand turn in the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.

Application

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

SCHEDULE 1

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES

The entire length of the A40 southbound entry slip road at Raglan Interchange to its junction with the A449 carriageway.

SCHEDULE 2

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF RIGHT HAND TURN

The right hand turn from the westbound carriageway of the A40 Raglan Bypass on to Mitchel Troy Road.

SCHEDULE 3

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF LEFT HAND TURN

The left hand turn from the westbound carriageway of the Raglan Bypass on to Monmouth Road.
