Coming into force

The Welsh Ministers, as the traffic authority for the St Clears to Pembroke Dock Trunk Road (A477), the London to Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) and the Haverfordwest to Milford Haven Trunk Road (A4076) ("the trunk roads"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk roads should be prohibited by reason of the likelihood of danger to the public arising from the transportation of abnormal indivisible loads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 13 April 2015. Its title is The A477 Trunk Road (St Clears, Carmarthenshire to Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire), the A40 Trunk Road (Penblewin Roundabout to Haverfordwest and Haverfordwest to Fishguard, Pembrokeshire) and the A4076 Trunk Road

(Haverfordwest to Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2015.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the transportation of the abnormal indivisible loads giving rise to this Order;

"the lengths of the trunk roads" ("y darnau o'r cefnffyrdd") means the lengths of the main carriageways of the A477, A40 and A4076 Trunk Roads in the Counties of Carmarthenshire and Pembrokeshire described in the Schedule to this Order;

"transportation period" ("cyfnod y cludo") means that period commencing at 00:01 hours on 13 April 2015 and ending when the movement of the abnormal indivisible loads has been completed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall, during the transportation period, drive any vehicle or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk roads described in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

A477 TRUNK ROAD

- 1) The length of the A477 trunk road that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of St Clears Roundabout, Carmarthenshire to its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Waterloo Roundabout, Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire.
- 2) The entire length of the circulatory carriageway of Waterloo Roundabout, Pembroke Dock, Pembrokeshire.

A40 TRUNK ROAD

- 1) The length of the A40 trunk road that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Penblewin Roundabout, Pembrokeshire to its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Salutation Square Roundabout, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire.
- 2) The entire length of the circulatory carriageway of Salutation Square Roundabout, Pembrokeshire.
- 3) The length of the A40 trunk road that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Scotchwell Roundabout, Haverfordwest to its junction with the circulatory carriageway of Goodwick Roundabout, Fishguard.
- 4) The entire length of the circulatory carriageway of Scotchwell Roundabout, Haverfordwest.
- 5) The entire length of the circulatory carriageway of Goodwick Roundabout, Fishguard.

A4076 TRUNK ROAD

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Salutation Square Roundabout, Pembrokeshire to a point adjacent to the former Celtic Garage, St Lawrence Hill, Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire.
