# **ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A40 Trunk Road and Link Road (Travellers' Rest, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2015

Made	21 May 2015
Coming into force	1 June 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the London – Fishguard Trunk Road (A40) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road and link road should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

### **Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 1 June 2015. The title to this Order is The A40 Trunk Road (Travellers' Rest, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary 30 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2015.

#### **2.**—(1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("*y darnau o'r gefnffordd*") means the lengths of the trunk road at Travellers' Rest in the County of Carmarthenshire, specified in the Schedule to this Order;

"the lengths of the link road" ("y darnau o'r ffordd gyswllt") means the lengths of the link road connecting the westbound on and off slip roads of the trunk road to the Carmarthen Livestock Market and the Travellers' Rest overbridge, respectively, in the County of Carmarthenshire, specified in the Schedule to this Order;

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

#### Restriction

**3.** Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour, in the lengths of the trunk road and link road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

#### Application

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

#### **Duration of this Order**

**5.** The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.

#### **SCHEDULE**

1. The lengths of the westbound off and on slip roads of Travellers' Rest Junction and link road to Carmarthen Livestock Market that extends from a point 67 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with the southern link road to Travellers' Rest overbridge to a point 543 metres west of the centre-point of the said junction.

2. The length of the link road to Travellers' Rest overbridge which extends from its junction with the link road to Carmarthen Livestock Market in an easterly direction for 200 metres.
