**The A40 Trunk Road (Nantgaredig
to White Mill, Carmarthenshire)
(Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit)
Order 2015**

Made 24 July 2015

Coming into force 29 July 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Llandeilo – Carmarthen Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 29 July 2015 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Nantgaredig to White Mill, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2015.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the trunk road between Nantgaredig and White Mill in the County of Carmarthenshire that extends from a point 240 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the B4310 to Nantgaredig to a point 1,356 metres east of its junction with the C2050 Class III road to White Mill.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Restriction

3. Subject to the provisions of article 4, no person shall ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

Application

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
