The A5 Trunk Road (Bethesda, Gwynedd) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2013 (Variation) Order 2015

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the London to Holyhead Trunk Road (A5) ("the trunk road"), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) ("the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of the North Wales Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 01 December 2015 and its title is The A5 Trunk Road (Bethesda, Gwynedd) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2013 (Variation) Order 2015.

Variation

2. The A5 Trunk Road (Bethesda, Gwynedd) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2013 is hereby varied and shall have affect as follows:-

(i) After article 5, insert—

"5A. Except as provided in article 6(3), no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 4".

(ii) After article 6(2), insert—:

"(3) Nothing in article 5A shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of the trunk road referred to in that article for so long as may be necessary in connection with the operations and duties specified in articles 6(1)(c), 6(1)(d), 6(1)(f) and 6(1)(g)."

- (iii) For the Schedule 1 heading substitute, "Prohibition of waiting except as provided in article 6(1)".
- (iv) In Schedule 3, paragraph 3, line 5, substitute"20 metres" for "26 metres".

(v) After Schedule 3, insert—

"SCHEDULE 4

Prohibition of waiting except as provided in article 6(3) (Outside Bethesda Police Station)

1. That length of the southern side of the trunk road known as Bethesda High Street which extends from a point 20 metres north west of the centre point of its junction with Glanafon Street to a point 26 metres northwest of the said junction outside the property known as Bethesda Police Station."
