TheA483TrunkRoad(Ammanford,Carmarthenshire)(Temporary 10MPHSpeedLimitand NoOvertaking)Order 2015

Made	12 January 2015
Coming into force	19 January 2015

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Swansea – Manchester Trunk Road (A483) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted and prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 19 January 2015. Its title is The A483 Trunk Road (Ammanford, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary 10 MPH Speed Limit and No Overtaking) Order 2015.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"the length of the trunk road" ("*y* darn o'r gefnffordd") means the length of the trunk road at Ammanford in the County of Carmarthenshire which extends from a point 383 metres south of the centrepoint of its junction with Glynhir Road southwards to the centre-point of its junction with Florence Road;

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on 19 January 2015 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition and Restriction

3. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, ride, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, to proceed at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 5, no person shall, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle in the length of the trunk road during such times as the restriction referred to in article 3 is in operation.

Application

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction and prohibition referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
