**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

The A40 Trunk Road (Llandovery,  
Broad Street and Kings Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition and  
Restriction of Waiting and Loading)  
Order 2016

*Made* 9 November 2016

*Coming into force* 22 November 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Raglan – Llandovery Trunk Road (A40) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and/or restricted because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

1. This Order comes into force on 22 November 2016 and its title is The A40 Trunk Road (Llandovery, Broad Street and Kings Road) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

“the length(s) of the trunk road” (“*y darn(au) o’r gefnffordd*”) means those lengths of the trunk road in the County of Carmarthenshire specified in the Schedules to this Order;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 22

November 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibition and Restriction**

#### **Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading at any time**

3. No person shall, during the works period, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at any time on the sides of the lengths of the trunk roads specified in Schedule 1.

#### **Prohibition of Waiting at any time**

4. No person shall, during the works period, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of the lengths of the trunk roads specified in Schedule 2.

#### **Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading (07:30-09:30 and 15:30-04:00 hours)**

5. No person shall, during the works period, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load between the times of 07:30 – 09:30 and 15:30 – 04:00 on the sides of the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 3.

#### **Loading and Unloading Only (04:00 – 07:30 and 09:30–15:30 hours)**

6. No person shall, during the works period, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to load or unload on the side of the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 4 at any time other than between 04:00 – 07:30 and 09:30 – 15:30 on any day.

### **Application**

7. The prohibitions and restrictions in articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Suspension**

8. The provisions of The Trunk Road (Various Streets, Llandovery) (Restriction of Waiting) Order

1973(1) are suspended insofar as they apply to the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 4 during such times as the prohibitions and restriction specified in articles 3 to 6 are in operation.

#### **Duration of this Order**

9. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.

## **SCHEDULE 1**

### **Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading at any time**

- i) The southern side of Broad Street from a point 36 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway to a point 53 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway.
- ii) The northern side of Kings Road from its junction with Market Square to a point 98 metres east from its junction with Market Square.
- iii) The southern side of Kings Road from a point 53 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway to a point 77 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway.
- iv) The southern side of Kings Road from a point 89 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway to a point 153 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway.

## SCHEDULE 2

### Prohibition of Waiting at any time

- i) The northern side of Kings Road from a point 60 metres west of the centre of Stone Street to a point 78 metres west of the centre of Castle Street.
- ii) The southern side of Kings Road from a point 60 metres west of the centre of Stone Street to a point 83 metres west of the centre of Stone Street.

## SCHEDULE 3

### Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading (07:30-09:30 and 15:30-04:00 hours)

The southern side of Kings Road from a point 77 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway to a point 89 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway between the times of 07:30 – 09:30 and 15:30 – 4:00.

## SCHEDULE 4

### Loading and Unloading Only (04:00 – 07:30 and 09:30–15:00 hours)

The southern side of Kings Road from a point 77 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway to a point 89 metres east of the western kerb line of Queensway between the times of 04:00 – 07:30 and 09:30 – 15:30.
