**The A494 Trunk Road (Eastbound
Carriageway between Queensferry
Interchange & Deeside Park
Interchange, Flintshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists &
Pedestrians) Order 2016**

Coming into force

6 June 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Dolgellau – South of Birkenhead Trunk Road (A494) (“the trunk road”), are satisfied that traffic in a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) and of all other enabling powers(2), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 6 June 2016 and its title is The A494 Trunk Road (Eastbound Carriageway between Queensferry Interchange & Deeside Park Interchange, Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2016.

2. —(1) In this Order:

“the length of the trunk road” (“*y darn o’r gefnffordd*”) means the length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at Queensferry Interchange (including the eastbound entry slip road at this interchange) to the eastbound entry slip road of the A550 at Deeside Park Interchange in the County of Flintshire;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 19:00 hours on 6 June 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of the trunk road.

4. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the length of the trunk road.

5. Subject to the provisions of article 6, no pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the prohibitions referred to therein is indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 12 months.
