ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A483 and A458 Trunk Roads (Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Vehicles and Pedestrians) Order 2016

Made 3 June 2016

Coming into force 19 June 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road (A483) and the Shrewsbury to Dolgellau Trunk Road (A458) ("the trunk roads"), are satisfied that all traffic on specified lengths of the trunk roads should be prohibited and/or restricted whilst the Welshpool Air Show is taking place.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 19 June 2016. Its title is The A483 and A458 Trunk Roads (Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Vehicles and Pedestrians) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"the lengths of the trunk roads" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means those lengths of the A483 and A458 trunk roads at Welshpool in the County of Powys described in the Schedules to this Order;

"prohibition period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 06:00 hours on 19 June 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article or Schedule is a reference to the article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition and Restriction

- 3. No person shall, during the prohibition period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the carriageway of the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, except on the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer.
- 4. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, police community support officer or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order during the prohibition period for a period longer than 45 minutes in any period of 1 hour 45 minutes.
- **5**. No person shall, during the prohibition period, be allowed to wait on the trunk road verge of the lengths of trunk roads specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order.

Application

6. The prohibitions and restrictions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 6 months.

SCHEDULE 1 CLEARWAY

That length of the A483 extending approximately 4350 metres from The Old Station Roundabout Welshpool through and including Sarnybryncaled Roundabout to the centre point of the junction of Trehelig Lane, in the county of Powys.

That length of the A458 extending approximately 1140 metres from Sarnybryncaled Roundabout to the centre point of the junction of Red Lane (to Powis Castle), in the county of Powys.

SCHEDULE 2

WAITING RESTRICTIONS

That entire length of the A483 southbound carriageway layby between The Old Station and Sarnbryncaled roundabouts, in the county of Powys.

That entire length of the A483 northbound carriageway layby between Sarnbryncaled and The Old Station roundabouts, in the county of Powys.

That entire length of the A483 southbound carriageway layby between The Moat Farm and Trehelig Lane, in the county of Powys.
