The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 36 (The Warren) to Junction 35 (Dobshill), Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2016

Made

25 August 2016

Coming into force

4 September 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Chester – Bangor Trunk Road (A55) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that all traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 4 September 2016 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 36 (The Warren) to Junction 35 (Dobshill), Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("*cerbyd esempt*") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the lengths of the trunk road" ("y darnau o'r gefnffordd") means:

i. the length of the A55 westbound carriageway that extends from the nosing of the westbound exit slip road of Junction 36 (The Warren), Flintshire to the nosing of the westbound entry slip road of Junction 35 (Dobshill), Flintshire;

ii. the entire lengths of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 36 (The Warren) and the westbound exit slip road at Junction 35 (Dobshill).

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means the period commencing at 20:00 on the 4 September 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

4. No person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the lengths of the trunk road.

5. No pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7.The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
