ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 8 (Llanfair PG), Isle of Anglesey to Junction 9 (Treborth), Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016

Made 31 August 2016

Coming into force 5 September 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London – Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) ("trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic in specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 5 September 2016 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 8 (Llanfair PG), Isle of Anglesey to Junction 9 (Treborth), Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2016.

2. (1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length(s) of the trunk road" ("y darn(au) o'r gefnffordd") means:

i. the entire length of the eastbound exit slip road at Junction 8 (Llanfair PG), Isle of Anglesey;

ii. the entire length of the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 8A (Carreg Bran), Isle of Anglesey; and

iii. the entire lengths of the westbound exit and entry slip roads at Junction 9 (Treborth), Gwynedd;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on 5 September 2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibition

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to be driven in the lengths of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
