The A55 Trunk Road (Westbound Entry Slip Road at Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange), Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2016

Made 5 September 2016

Coming into force 12 September 2016

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the Chester – Bangor Trunk Road (A55) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that all traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 12 September 2016. Its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Westbound Entry Slip Road at Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road Interchange), Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2016.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the length of the trunk road" ("y darn o'r gefnffordd") means the entire length of the westbound entry slip road of the A55 trunk road at Junction 10 (Caernarfon Road), in the County of Gwynedd;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 12 September

2016 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed along the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** No person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle in the length of the trunk road.
- **5.** No pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed in the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order shall be 18 months.
