# ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A470 Trunk Road (Storey Arms, Powys) (Temporary Parttime 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2017

Made 29 September 2017

Coming into force 06 October 2017

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the Cardiff – Llangurig Trunk Road (A470) ("the trunk road"), are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

### **Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 06 October 2017 and its title is The A470 Trunk Road (Storey Arms, Powys) (Temporary Part-time 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2017.

**2.**—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means:

(a) any vehicle being used by the emergency services; and

- (b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—
- (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
- (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

"special forces" ("lluoedd arbennig") means those units of the home forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director.

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A470 Cardiff – Llangurig trunk road at Storey Arms in the County of Powys that extends from a point 800 metres north of the centre-point of its junction with the A4059 to a point 600 metres west of the western access to the Storey Arms Centre.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

### Restriction

**3.**No person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of the trunk road.

### **Application**

**4.**The provisions of article 3 apply only during such times and to such extent as the application of the restriction referred to therein is indicated by activated traffic signs.

#### **Duration of this Order**

**5.**The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
