ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads between Junction 8 (Ael y Bowl), Anglesey & Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2017

Made 17 November 2017

Coming into force 22 November 2017

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the relevant length of the London to Holyhead Trunk Road (A55) and the Chester to Bangor Trunk Road (A55), are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk roads should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Interpretation and Commencement

1. This Order comes into force on 22 November 2017 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads between Junction 8 (Ael y Bowl), Anglesey & Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2017.

2.—(1) In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in

connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk roads" ("y cefnffyrdd") means the London to Holyhead trunk road (A55) on the Isle of Anglesey and the Chester to Bangor trunk road (A55) in the County of Gwynedd;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 22 November 2017 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a numbered article is a reference to the article bearing that number in this Order.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule.
- **4.** No person shall, during the works period, ride or cause to be ridden, any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule.
- **5.** No pedestrian shall, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
