**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 3
(Pen Caledog Interchange) to
Junction 8 (Ael y Bowl
Interchange), Isle of Anglesey)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles,
Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2018**

Made 7 November 2018

Coming into force 12 November 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 3 (Pen Caledog Interchange) to Junction 8 (Ael y Bowl Interchange), Isle of Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 12 November 2018.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 London to Holyhead Trunk Road;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 12 November 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.

SCHEDULE

The length of the westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 250 metres east of Junction 4 (Dalar Hir Interchange) to a point 250 metres west of Junction 3 (Pen Caledog Interchange), including the westbound entry slip road at Junction 4 and westbound exit slip road at Junction 3.

The length of the eastbound and westbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 260 metres west of Junction 6 (Nant Turnpike Interchange) to a point 380 metres east of Junction 7

(Cefn Du Interchange), including the eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Junction 6 and the eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Junction 7.

The length of the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road that extends from a point 370 metres west of Junction 7 (Cefn Du Interchange) to a point 200 metres east of Junction 8 (Ael y Bowl Interchange), including the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 7 and eastbound exit slip road at Junction 8.
