

**2018 No. 973 (W. 198)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A465 Trunk Road (Exit Slip  
Roads at Rhymney Interchange,  
Rhymney, Caerphilly County  
Borough) (Temporary Prohibition  
of Vehicles) Order 2018**

*Made* 4 September 2018

*Coming into force* 10 September 2018

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A465 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title, Commencement and Interpretation**

**1.** The title of this Order is the A465 Trunk Road (Exit Slip Roads at Rhymney Interchange, Rhymney, Caerphilly County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2018 and it comes into force on 10 September 2018.

**2.** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempti*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A465 Neath to Abergavenny Trunk Road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 10 September 2018 and ending when the temporary traffic signs have been permanently removed.

### **Prohibition**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the lengths of the eastbound and westbound exit slip roads of the trunk road at Rhymney Interchange, Rhymney in the County Borough of Caerphilly.

### **Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
