ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A483 Trunk Road (Newtown Bypass, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Cyclists) Order 2019

Made	4 February 2019
Coming into force	11 February 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A483 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (Newtown Bypass, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles and Cyclists) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 11 February 2019.

2. In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("*cerbyd esempt*") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services, in connection with the works giving rise to this Order and to access appropriate properties;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the length of the A483 Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road

known as Newtown Bypass that extends from the eastern tip of the eastern junction serving Dyffryn Industrial Estate to its junction with the new roundabout at Pool Road, Newtown, Powys;

"works period" ("*cyfnod y gwaith*") means that period commencing at 09:00 hours on 11 February 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.

Application

5. The prohibitions in articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 6 months.
