The A55 Trunk Road (Westbound Carriageway at Junction 32a (Springfield), Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2019

Made 13 February 2019

Coming into force

18 February 2019

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Westbound Carriageway at Junction 32a (Springfield), Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists & Pedestrians) Order 2019 and it comes into force on 18 February 2019.

2. In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services and in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A55 Chester to Bangor Trunk Road in the County of Flintshire that extends from the nosing of the

westbound exit slip road to the nosing of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 32a (Springfield);

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 20:00 hours on 18 February 2019 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.
