**The A458 Trunk Road (Llanfair
Caereinion, Powys) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020**

Made 8 October 2020

Coming into force 13 October 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Llanfair Caereinion, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 13 October 2020.

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (*“y gefnffordd”*) means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 13 October

2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road that extends from the 30 mph speed limit terminal point at the south-western side of Llanfair Caereinion, Powys to the 30 mph speed limit terminal point at the north-eastern side of the town.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
