The A4076 & A40 Trunk Roads (Haverfordwest to Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2020

Made	14 April 2020
Coming into force	20 April 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A4076 trunk road and the relevant length of the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk roads should be restricted and/or prohibited because of works proposed on or near the roads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A4076 & A40 Trunk Roads (Haverfordwest to Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire) (Temporary Speed Restrictions & No Overtaking) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 20 April 2020.

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means:

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c.32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

- (a) any vehicle being used for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(2); and
- (b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

"special forces" (*"lluoedd arbennig"*) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

"the trunk roads" ("y cefnffyrdd") means the A4076 Haverfordwest to Milford Haven Trunk Road and the A40 London to Fishguard Trunk Road;

"works period" (*"cyfnod y gwaith"*) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 20 April 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Restrictions and Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedules to this Order.

5. No person may, during the works period, use or permit the use of a vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other vehicle on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedules to this Order during such times as the restriction referred to in article 4 is in operation.

Application

6.—(1) The restrictions and prohibition in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

(2) No speed limits imposed by this Order apply to an exempted vehicle.

Suspension

7. Any statutory provisions restricting the speed of vehicles on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedules to this Order are suspended during such times as the restrictions specified in articles 3 and 4 are in operation.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE 1 Temporary 40 mph or 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from a point 190 metres south of its junction with Salutation Square Roundabout to a point 43 metres east of its junction with Merlin's Bridge Roundabout, Haverfordwest.

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from a point 151 metres south-west of its junction with Old Hakin Road, Haverfordwest to a point 55 metres north of the centre of its junction with the U2299 unclassified road leading to Brickhurst Park, Johnston.

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from a point 103 metres south of its junction with Sunnycroft Roundabout, Johnston to a point 112 metres north of its junction with Thornton Road, Steynton.

SCHEDULE 2 Temporary 10 mph Speed Limit & No Overtaking

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from its junction with Salutation Square Roundabout, Haverfordwest to a point 190 metres south of that junction.

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from a point 43 metres east of its junction with Merlins Bridge Roundabout (including the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout) to a point 151 metres south-west of its junction with Old Hakin Road, Haverfordwest.

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from a point 55 metres north of the centre of its junction with the U2299 unclassified road to Brickhurst Park to a point 103 metres south of its junction with Sunnycroft Roundabout, Johnston.

The length of the A4076 trunk road that extends from a point 112 metres north of its junction with Thornton Road, Steynton to a point 140 metres west of its junction with Victoria Bridge Roundabout, Milford Haven, including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout.

The length of the A40 trunk road that extends from its junction with Salutation Square Roundabout (including its circulatory carriageway) to its junction with Scotchwell Roundabout, Haverfordwest.
