The A470 Trunk Road (Llanrwst, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Cyclists) Order 2020

5 May 2020 Made

Coming into force 11 May 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (Llanrwst, Conwy County Borough) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles & Cyclists) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 11 May 2020.

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the length of the A470 Maentwrog to East of Conwy trunk road that extends from its junction with Parry Road to its junction with the A548 Denbigh Street and the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the A548 Denbigh Street to its junction with the B5106 Pont Fawr;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on

11 May 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibition

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

Application

5. The prohibitions in articles 3 and 4 apply only at such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

6. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
