ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A479 Trunk Road (Glanusk Park to Bronllys, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020

Made 7 July 2020

Coming into force 10 July 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A479 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A479 Trunk Road (Glanusk Park to Bronllys, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 10 July 2020.

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the length of the A479 Glanusk Park to Llyswen trunk road that extends from the centre-point of its junction with the A40 trunk road at Glanusk Park to the roundabout junction with the A438 at Bronllys, Powys;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 00:01 hours on

10 July 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.
- **6.** No equestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.
- 7. No person may, during the works period, permit any livestock to proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

Application

8. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

9. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
