# ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A487 Trunk Road
(Aberystwyth, Ceredigion)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2020

Made 18 August 2020

Coming into force 24 August 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A487 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

### Title, Commencement and Interpretation

**1.** The title of this Order is the A487 Trunk Road (Aberystwyth, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 24 August 2020.

#### 2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road.

#### **Prohibition**

**3.** No person may drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road known as Bridge Street and Great Darkgate Street, Aberystwyth, Ceredigion that extends from the northernmost point of its junction with South Road to a point 105 metres north-east of the centre of its junction with Terrace Road.

#### **Application**

**4.** The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

#### **Duration of this Order**

**5.** The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
