ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A494 Trunk Road (Llanycil, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2020

Made 27 August 2020

Coming into force 2 September 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A494 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A494 Trunk Road (Llanycil, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 2 September 2020.

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A494 Dolgellau to South of Birkenhead trunk road that extends from a point 50 metres from Class C road to Parc to a point 215 metres south-west of the centrepoint of the western exit of Llanycil layby;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 12:00 on the 2 September 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
