The A489 & A483 Trunk Roads
(Newtown Bypass, Powys)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles,
Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order
2020

Made 4 September 2020

Coming into force 14 September 2020

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant lengths of the A489 & A483 Trunk Roads, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk roads should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the roads.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A489 & A483 Trunk Roads (Newtown Bypass, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Pedestrians and Cyclists) Order 2020 and it comes into force on 14 September 2020.

2. In this Order:

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services, in connection with the works giving rise to this Order and to access appropriate properties;

"the trunk roads" ("y cefnffyrdd") means the A489 Newtown to Aberystwyth Trunk Road and A483 Swansea to Manchester Trunk Road known as Newtown Bypass that extends from the Llanidloes Road Roundabout to Pool Road Roundabout, Newtown, Powys;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means that period commencing at 08:00 hours on 14 September 2020 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed on the length of the trunk roads.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk roads.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk roads.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4 and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
