# ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A44 Trunk Road (Goginan to Capel Bangor, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2021

Made 23 December 2021

Coming into force 3 January 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A44 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

#### Title and commencement

**1.** The title of this Order is the A44 Trunk Road (Goginan to Capel Bangor, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2021 and this Order comes into force on 3 January 2022.

#### Interpretation

#### 2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A44 Newtown to Aberystwyth trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 3 January 2022 and ending when the temporary

traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

#### **Prohibition**

**3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road that extends from a point 150 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the U1082 (signposted Old Goginan) to a point 490 metres north-east of the centre-point of its junction with the C1130, east of Capel Bangor, Ceredigion.

### **Application**

**4.** The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

#### **Duration of this Order**

**5.** The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
