The M4 Motorway (Junction 25A (Grove Park) to Junction 28 (Tredegar Park), Newport) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles with a weight in excess of 44 Tonnes) Order 2021

Made 27 May 2021

Coming into force 29 May 2021

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the M4 motorway, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the motorway should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public and the workforce.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the M4 Motorway (Junction 25A (Grove Park) to Junction 28 (Tredegar Park), Newport) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles with a weight in excess of 44 Tonnes) Order 2021 and this Order comes into force on 29 May 2021.

Interpretation

2. In this Order:

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006(c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle in connection with the works giving rise to this Order:

"the motorway" ("y draffordd") means the M4 London to South Wales Motorway;

"prohibition period" ("cyfnod y gwaharddiad") means the period commencing at 00:01 on the 29 May 2021 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the prohibition period, drive any vehicle with a weight in excess of 44 tonnes, on the lengths of the motorway specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

Temporary Prohibition of all Vehicles with a weight in excess of 44 Tonnes

- 1. The length of the eastbound carriageway of the M4 motorway that extends from the physical nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at Junction 28 to the physical nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 27 (Highcross), including the eastbound entry slip road at Junction 28.
- 2. The length of the westbound carriageway of the M4 motorway that extends from the physical nosing of the westbound exit slip road at Junction 25A to the

physical nosing of the westbound entry slip road at Junction 28.

- 3. The entire length of the westbound entry slip road from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Junction 26 to its junction with the main westbound carriageway.
- 4. The entire length of the westbound entry slip road from its junction with the main circulatory carriageway of Junction 27 to its junction with the main westbound carriageway.
