ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A55 Trunk Road (Eastbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads at Junction 9, Gwynedd) and the A487 Trunk Road (Link Road between Treborth Roundabout and Parc Menai Roundabout, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2021

Made 13 July 2021 Coming into force 19 July 2021

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A55 and A487 trunk roads, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk roads should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Eastbound Entry and Exit Slip Roads at Junction 9, Gwynedd) and the A487 Trunk Road (Link Road between Treborth Roundabout and Parc Menai Roundabout, Gwynedd) (Temporary Prohibition of

Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians) Order 2021 and this Order comes into force on 19 July 2021.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"the trunk roads" ("y cefnffyrdd") means the A55 Chester to Bangor trunk road and the A487 Fishguard to Bangor trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 19:00 on the 19 July 2021 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Application

6. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4, and 5 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE

Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles, Cyclists and Pedestrians

- **1.** The length of the A55 Junction 9 eastbound entry slip road.
- **2.** The length of the A55 Junction 9 eastbound exit slip road.
- **3.** The length of the A487 trunk road between Junction 9 West (Parc Menai) Roundabout and Junction 9 East (Treborth Road) Roundabout including the entire circulatory carriageway of Treborth Roundabout.
