The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Gwynedd to Junction 15 (Llanfairfechan Roundabout), Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions) Order 2021

Made 27 January 2021

Coming into force 1 February 2021

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title, Commencement and Interpretation

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Gwynedd to Junction 15 (Llanfairfechan Roundabout), Conwy) (Temporary Traffic Prohibitions) Order 2021 and it comes into force on 1 February 2021.

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A55 Chester to Bangor trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 1 February

2021 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

- **3.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- **4.** No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- **5.** No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the lengths of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- **6.** No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle so as to make a right-hand turn or U-turn from one carriageway to another through the gaps in the central reservation on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Application

7. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

8. The maximum duration for this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE 1 Temporary prohibition of vehicles, cyclists & pedestrians

The length of the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the trunk road that extends from the centre of Junction 11 (Llys y Gwynt Interchange), Gwynedd to the centre of Junction 15 (Llanfairfechan Roundabout), Conwy, including the eastbound and westbound entry slip roads from Junctions 11 to 15.

SCHEDULE 2 Temporary prohibition of right-hand/U-turns

The length of the trunk road that extends from the centre of Junction 12 (Tal-y-bont) to the centre of Junction 13 (Abergwyngregyn).
