ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A483 Trunk Road (The Strand, Builth Wells, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022

Made 14 June 2022

Coming into force 24 June 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A483 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (The Strand, Builth Wells, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 24 June 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order:

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A483 Swansea to Manchester trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 24 June 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road known as The Strand that extends from a point 5 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with North Road to a point 5 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with Strand Street at Builth Wells in the County of Powys.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
