The A458 Trunk Road (Trewern, Powys) (40 mph & 50 mph Speed Limits) Order 2023

Made 2 February 2023

Coming into force 6 February 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 trunk road, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 84(1)(a), 84(2) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with the Chief Officer of Dyfed-Powys Police and given public notice of their intention to make this Order in accordance with regulations 5(1) and 6(1) of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1990(2).

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Trewern, Powys) (40 mph & 50 mph Speed Limits) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 6 February 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"exempted vehicle" ("cerbyd esempt") means:

- (a) any vehicle being used for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1);
- (b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;

"special forces" ("lluoedd arbennig") means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director:

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road.

Restrictions

- **3.** No person may drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- **4.** No person may drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Revocation

5. The A458 Trunk Road (Trewern, Powys) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2001(**2**) and the A458 Trunk Road (Buttington to Cefn Bridge, Powys) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2017(**3**) are revoked.

SCHEDULE 1 40 mph speed limit

The length of the trunk road at Trewern, Powys that extends from a point 555 metres west of the centrepoint of its junction with the U2248 Sale Lane to a point 289 metres north-east of the centre-point of its junction with the western leg of the U2245 Garreg Bank.

SCHEDULE 2 50 mph speed limit

The length of the trunk road at Trewern, Powys that extends from a point 40 metres east of the eastern side of Buttington Cross Roundabout to a point 555 metres west of the centre-point of its junction with the U2248 Sale Lane.
