ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES

The A48 Trunk Road (Eastbound Exit Slip Road at Cwmgwilli, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023

Made 17 November 2023

Coming into force 28 November 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A48 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A48 Trunk Road (Eastbound Exit Slip Road at Cwmgwilli, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 28 November 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

"the trunk road" ("y gefnffordd") means the A40 London to Fishguard trunk road;

"works period" ("cyfnod y gwaith") means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on the 28

November 2023 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the entire length of the eastbound exit slip road of the A48 trunk road at Cwmgwilli in the County of Carmarthenshire.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 6 months.
