**The A470 Trunk Road (Northbound
Entry Slip Road at Taffs Well,
Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023**

Made 3 January 2023

Coming into force 9 January 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A470 Cardiff to Llangurig trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A470 Trunk Road (Northbound Entry Slip Road at Taffs Well, Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 9 January 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*ystyr cerbyd esempt*”) means vehicles making abnormal load deliveries to the Transport for Wales Depot at Taffs Well;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A470 Cardiff to Llangurig trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on 9 January 2023 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle on the length of the northbound entry slip road of the trunk road at Taffs Well, Rhondda Cynon Taf that extends from its junction with Cardiff Road, 180 metres northwest of the Taffs Well Interchange Roundabout to its junction with the main northbound carriageway of the trunk road.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
