**The A458 Trunk Road (Llanerfyl,
Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of
Vehicles) Order 2023**

Made 23 January 2023

Coming into force 30 January 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Llanerfyl, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 30 January 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means:

- (i) any vehicle being used by the emergency services;
- (ii) any vehicle being used in connection with works giving rise to this Order or for winter gritting on the length of the road concerned;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:00 hours on 30 January 2023 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the A458 trunk road that extends from its junction with the U2348 road at the eastern side of Llanerfyl Bridge to its junction with the C2031 road at the western side of Llanerfyl Bridge.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
