## MIDLAND LEASEHOLD VALUATION TRIBUNAL

## BACKGROUND

This was an application by the Tenants, Mr.and Mrs. P.J.Peel to determine the costs of their Landlord, St. Ermins Property Co Ltd payable by them pursuant to $\operatorname{Sec} 9$ (4) of the Leasehold Reform Act 1967 in connection with the enfranchisement of their property No. 7 Darley Way Streetly Sutton Coldfield B74 2JQ

## HEARING

Mr. J.Moore of Messrs.Midland Valuations appeared for the applicants. The Landlords were not represented. Mr. Moore submitted that in accordance with the Tribunal's present practice in such matters a reasonable legal fee for the conveyancing involved might be $£ 225$ (plus VAT if applicable) and $£ 8$ for Land Registry Office Copies (the title being known to be registered)
So far as a valuation fee was concerned, there was no evidence to indicate that a valuation had been undertaken in response to his clients' Notice given on $25^{\text {th }}$ May 2001 and there had certainly been no internal inspection of the property to his clients' knowledge.

## DECISION

We determine for the purposes of this Application that the Tenants should pay the Landlord's reasonable costs in the sum of $£ 225$ for legal work (and VAT if applicable) plus the $£ 8$ Land Registry fee for office copies.
