DECISION

Summary of decision

- 1. The legal fees payable by the Applicant amount to a total of £1130.00 plus VAT of £226.00 and disbursements of £48.00.
- 2. The professional surveyor's fees payable by the Applicant amount to £250.00 plus VAT of £50.00.

Background

- 3. This application, with the consent of the parties, was decided on the papers alone, the Tribunal having been provided with an agreed bundle of relevant documents.
- 4. The application solely relates to legal and surveyor's fees incurred by the Respondent, the Applicant having withdrawn her claim to a new lease.

Legal fees

- 5. It appeared to the Tribunal that this was a routine transaction. There was little to investigate by way of title, the tenant's claim being straight-forward. There was a suggestion in the written submissions put to the Tribunal that a great deal of time was taken by the Respondent's solicitors in drafting a new lease and in dealing with amendments proposed by the Applicant. However there was no detail on what this work actually amounted to or why there was a need for a lease with substantially new lease terms.
- 6. In the circumstances, the Tribunal has allowed the fixed fee for general advice regarding the matter in the sum of £450.00 plus VAT. As to the remainder of the legal fees. On the detail available to it, the Tribunal considers that a further four hours of legal work would be reasonable on a transaction such as this. The hourly rate of £170.00 is reasonable. This gives a fee of £680 plus VAT of £136.00.

Surveyor's Fees

7. The surveyor's fees claimed by the Respondent were reduced by his response to the application to £250.00 plus VAT with an explanation as to the work done for this fee which the Tribunal accepts.
