## DECISION

Having regard to the evidence submitted by the parties, the Tribunal determines that, pursuant to section 20ZA(1) it is reasonable to dispense with the consultation requirements in relation to the qualifying works, namely, the roofing works to the Property.

In making this determination, the Tribunal noted that there had been consultation with all leaseholders, including the Respondent, regarding the need for the roofing works to be done and with regard to the selection of contractors (although not in compliance with the statutory procedure set out in section 20 Landlord and Tenant Act 1985). Further, the evidence submitted by both parties indicated that the Respondent accepted the need for the works to be done, and was willing to pay his contribution to those works.
