MERGER ANNOUNCEMENT

Competition and Consumer Protection Commission clears proposed acquisition of Charleville Park Hotel by Atlantic Troy Limited.

The Competition and Consumer Protection Commission has today cleared the proposed transaction whereby Atlantic Troy Limited would acquire sole control of the Charleville Park Hotel. The proposed transaction was notified under the Competition Act 2002 (as amended) on 27 January 2015.

The Commission has formed the view that the proposed transaction will not substantially lessen competition in any market for goods or services in the State. The Commission will publish the reasons for its determination on its website no later than 60 working days after the date of the Determination and after allowing the parties the opportunity to request that confidential information be removed from the published version.

Additional Information

Atlantic Troy Limited owns and operates the Castletroy Park Hotel in County Limerick and Loughrea Hotel and Spa in County Galway. Atlantic Troy Limited is a wholly owned subsidiary of Supermac's Holdings Limited.

Supermac's Holdings Limited is also involved, through various wholly owned subsidiaries, in (i) the operation of approximately 100 Supermac's-brand fast food outlets in Ireland and (ii) operating the Barack Obama Plaza located near Moneygall on the M7 motorway between Dublin and Limerick.

The Charleville Park Hotel is a four star hotel and its facilities include 91 bedrooms, 5 executive suites, a leisure club, swimming pool, jacuzzi, steam room, sauna and gym facilities.
