LIEUTENANT BAILIFF: "As the Solicitor General pointed out, it is tantamount to contempt of Court, to show disrespect for an order of this Court. The shoplifting was persistent and was carried out for some while. You did not need to steal as you were earning and were in deliberate breach of a probation order. The Court has no doubt that this merits a custodial sentence. The Court will therefore grant the Solicitor General's conclusions: firstly, the probation order will be discharged, and secondly, that on counts I to 22, you will go to prison for 6 months on each charge, each one concurrent with each other.
