JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The Court makes the following orders:

- 1. for immediate vacant possession of the whole of the property number 4 High Street, St Aubin, and directing the Viscount, tomorrow morning, to evict the defendant, all members of his family and all other occupants of the premises and to remove therefrom all their personal furniture and possessions not included in the sale of the property;
- 2. authorising officers of the honorary and/or States police forces to assist the Viscount in carrying out order 1 above;
- 3. ordering the occupants of the caretaker's flat at 4 St Saviour's Crescent to hand over to the Viscount at 8 o'clock tomorrow morning all the keys in their possession relating either to the whole premises or any individual flat or room;
- 4. approving the intention of the Autorisés in default of such keys to have all locks on the premises changed and new keys provided;
- 5. restraining the defendant from attending at 4 St Saviour's Crescent in any manner whatsoever, whether by himself or his agents;
- 6. authorising the Viscount, with the assistance of officers of the honorary and/or States police forces if necessary. to ensure that orders 3, 4 and 5 above are fully complied with.

Now, at this stage, we make no further order for the accounting of the proceeds of 4 St Saviour's Crescent but reserve the

matter to be considered when the whole question of contempt is heard.

PUTY BAILIFF: With regard to the contempt alleged in the Representation of the 23rd January, 1987, of the Autorisés, the Court notes that Mr Benest is prepared to advise the Autorisés not to pursue the matter. In the circumstances, the Court does not propose to take any further action in the matter.

The regard to Order 3 of the 26th January, 1987, for the accounting of income from 4 St Saviour's Crescent, the Court adjourns the consideration of the defendant's contempt of that Order to another day.

With regard to Order 5 of the 26th January, 1987, about the keys of 4 St Saviour's Crescent, the Court, having regard to the further orders made today, does not propose to take any further action.

The Court declares that, in accordance with the terms the Loi 1839, Sur les Remises de Biens, the whole of the costs of the Autorisés shall be payable out of the assets in the 'remise'.
