The Bailiff: Your client - the fact remains that if all he did with the knife is as you have been instructed, that to us in fact would not have been an offence at all. However, having regard to the circumstances and the facts of this case we cannot think that the conclusions asked for are wrong, and therefore Dowden you are sentenced in respect of Count 1 to nine months, Counts 2 to 5 9 months concurrent and to the breach of probation six months concurrent with each other and consecutive to the present offences making a total of fifteen months and the two probation orders are discharged.
