THE BAILIFF: We think that insufficient allowance was made by the learned Magistrate for the fact that this man really was in relation to this offence a first offender, and therefore we are going to vary the sentence and allow the appeal to some extent. The fine will be reduced to one hundred and fifty pounds and the disqualification to nine months.
