**JUDGMENT**

THE BAILIFF: Well, Buckley, having pleaded guilty, having nothing to tell us and not having the benefit of more up to date reports, we have had to rely on what we have read, there is no doubt to us that within a very short time of coming out of prison you started committing further offences and even allowing for the eventual co-operation, you were not co-operative to start with. We cannot see that the conclusions asked for by Her Majesty's Attorney General are wrong. You are sentenced to fifteen months.
