DEPUTY BAILIFF: We have made our own separate enquiries because the Court is anxious to help someone who is unrepresented. However, Cassin, you failed to reveal to us that you were in conversation with your counsel Advocate Messervy as recently as yesterday and that Mr. Messervy and Mr. Jordan are going to see you very soon on, among other things, this agreement dated the 15th February, 1989. You also failed to tell Mr. Messervy that you were making this application this morning.

We have asked the Greffier to expedite the hearing before the Superior Number of your application for leave to withdraw your abandonment of Appeal. If you are successful in your application, you can go on either to have your Appeal heard immediately or to apply for bail pending the hearing of that Appeal. In the meantime, today's application is refused.
