JUDGMENT

THE BAILIFF: Edwards, there is no doubt in the minds of the Court that you came over here deliberately to defraud people in this Island. We can see no reason to differ from the conclusions of the Solicitor General. You are an intelligent man, you must know the consequences of your actions and people who take the actions as you did, knowing full well what might happen must bear the proper consequences. You are sentenced to eighteen months' imprisonment, concurrent, in respect of each count.
