## JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The application for bail is refused. It would be totally contrary to the policy of this Court with regard to class "A" drugs and it is as the Attorney said only in exceptional circumstances that bail will be granted to a person who is already convicted, particularly where a custodial sentence is inevitable.

Therefore, Pockett, you are remanded in custody to appear before the Superior Number of this Court on the 5th February, 1991, at 10 a.m. for your sentence.
