Possession of Class 'A' drugs with intent to supply; supplying Class'A' drugs; possession of amphetamine sulphate (Class 'B')

PLEA:

Guilty

DETAILS OF OFFENCE:

Arrested in possession of 35 paper squares of LSD; admitted having sold 15 such squares earlier that same day. Had been trading in Class 'A' drugs for previous month. Operated on a "Sale or return basis" feeding his own habit from the profit margin. The amphetamine sulphate also found on him at the time of arrest was a "personal" quantity.

DETAILS OF MITIGATION:

Children's Law applied. Sentence in excess of 3 years was a real possibility. However, an express desire to break free of drugs combined with extreme youth made borstal a realistic option.

PREVIOUS CONVICTIONS:

Many - but clean record on drugs.

CONCLUSIONS:

Borstal on each count concurrently.

SENTENCE AND OBSERVATIONS OF THE COURT:

Extreme youth was the determining factor. Conclusions granted.

DETAILS OF OFFENCE:

Save for one offence involving TTSand RP the premises involved were commercial (shops, hotels, cafés and a food warehouse/offices).

Youth: full co-operation.

JUDGMENT

LIEUTENANT BAILIFF: The Court has given considerable thought to the appropriate sentences. You have caused an immense amount of damage and trouble in the Island.

JJS, you may be grateful to the Crown Advocate and the Probation Service that you are not going to prison for a very long time. You will have a very last chance to change your ways. You have pleaded guilty to all counts and are sentenced to Borstal Training.

Before sentencing the remainder I will remind you that this is a chance for you to alter your ways. Should you not comply with the orders you will be brought back here and sentenced for those offences. Now that is absolutely clear to all of you.

RP , on all accounts you pleaded guilty; you are sentenced to one year's Probation Order with two hundred and forty hours Community Service; in addition you are placed on probation for three years, to run concurrently. And, also you will attend the Offending Behaviour Group.

IT., you are sentenced to one year's Probation with one hundred and eighty hours Community Service. In addition you will be on Probation for two years to run concurrently.

NA you are also sentenced to one year's Probation with one hundred and eighty hours Community Service plus a two year Probation Order to run concurrently.

 $\ensuremath{\operatorname{JCS}}$, you are sentenced to one year's probation on its own.
