JUDGMENT

THE BAILIFF: We note, Mr. Crane, that your client expresses a wish to make an attempt to have nothing more to do with drugs, and we think we can make a slight allowance because he has been completely frank and honest with the police. Accordingly, we reduce the conclusions by two months. You are sentenced on Count 1 to 10 months' imprisonment; on Count 2, one month's imprisonment

concurrent; and on Count 3, to one month's imprisonment concurrent, making a total of 10 months' imprisonment. The drugs are to be forfeited and are to be destroyed.
